



## Area Service Report – January 2018


Hi Family,

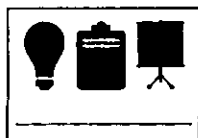



They seem to be extremely laid back but they are willing for PR to go into the program to perform a public relations. We are going to make a literature purchase to add schedules and IPs. We are also going to ask if they would like a literature rack. We do have at least one in stock so we would just work with the literature chair to fulfill these orders. We have already discussed some information with other members of the area to assist with this. We will be reporting back more information as it becomes available. We will look into doing this within the next few weeks.

Aaron also reached out to Stark MHAR, which is the overhead committee that handles the county's action services. This is an umbrella entity which includes the Crisis Intervention & Commquest. She is going to add stacsna.org to their information site. They already have the website for the Ohio Region.

Aaron also reach out to the court administrator, who was not very helpful. We are going to focus on the other 2 programs that are willing to work with us. The representation from Stark MHAR also suggested getting involved with the Opiate Task Force. Aaron will be attending the meeting on 1/19/18.
