



Area Service Report – January 2018


Hi Family,

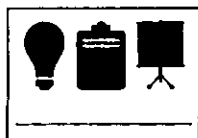


